Making Tracks is a trail-blazing and inclusive community access program that offers diverse activities that allow OnTrack Tasmania Participants to engage in a safe and supportive environment.

We have two centrally-located community hubs which include a creative art space, a fully-equiped music studio, a commercial kitchen and a video gaming area.

Our dedicated staff will support you to develop core skills through fun and engaging programs and activities with no out-of-pocket expenses.

ARTS AND CRAFTS

Explore your creativity and self-expression with a range of mediums such as clay, textiles, paints and more, in a safe and nurturing environment. Our art program leaders will guide you every step of the way and inspire you to create masterpieces. We run an annual art exhibition to provide a platform for Participants to share their work with the public, celebrate their achievements, and even sell their artwork.



COOKING

Develop your confidence in the kitchen and learn new recipes and healthy eating habits through our cooking program. Our program also encourages social interaction and teamwork amongst our Participants, creating a supportive and inclusive community. Join and discover the joy of cooking with the help of a qualified chef!

SPORTS

Our Participants assist in running this program with their support workers three days a week. Sports days include indoor soccer, basketball, tenpin bowling, mini golf, indoor cricket and more. Sports days also include a weekly BBQ lunch!

MUSIC

Our fully equipped music studio is the perfect place to explore your passion for playing different instruments, record songs and upload them to YouTube. From guitars, piano, drums and singing, you will unlock a whole new level of creativity. With our qualified music teacher, you'll receive expert guidance as you build your skills and discover new talents.

DIGITAL LITERACY PROGRAM

Our interactive sessions provide a safe and supportive space to learn about technology and the internet. Our video gaming program offers a safe and welcoming environment where Participants can connect with fellow gamers, share and stream their gameplay sessions, and experience the excitement of friendly competition. You will have access to retro games, modern games and a virtual reality headset to take your gaming experience to the next level!

KARAOKE PROGRAM

A fun and inclusive way for Participants to build their confidence, express themselves, and make new friends.
